School Business

- Parents/guardians who must take their children home early from school must sign them out at the secretary's office.
- Pupils from 3rd/4th class will not be allowed to leave the school early unless collected by parents/guardians. Pupils from 5th/6th class who need to leave during school time must have a note signed by parents/guardians.
- All absences from school <u>must</u> be explained by a note from parents/guardians. This is a requirement of the National Educational Welfare Board.
 - 4. The roll will be called every morning at 10.50am. Pupils will be marked either present or absent at the time of roll call. If pupils arrive after this time they will be marked absent and a record will be kept of the time of their arrival to school.
- 5. Please check your child's school journal regularly as it is a method of communication between the school and yourself. If you need to meet a teacher please make an appointment via the diary or through Mairead in the office.
 - Let us know if you have changed your phone numbers as we must have an up to date number at which you can be contacted in case of an emergency.
- 7. Meetings for parents of 3rd class pupils will be held at the end of September.
- 8. Reminder that mobile phones are not allowed in school. However, in extreme circumstances where a pupil may need access to a phone for after school, they may bring it to school and hand it in to the principal's office where it will be kept safe and returned to the pupil at the end of the day.
