Green/Healthy Schools

We are a Healthy Eating school and soft drinks of any kind are not allowed in the school. Pupils are encouraged to drink water or milk in school. We are doing our bit for the global Plastic Pollution problem and are delighted that bottled water is no longer delivered to the school each day. We now have special filtered water taps in all classrooms and pupils have their own Water Bottle which they may use. Thanks to the Green School Committee for helping us with this initiative. Last year we used a staggering 79,000 plastic bottles for water—this is the equivalent of 11 kilomeneters of bottles in one school year.

Anti Bullying Questionnaires

Anti bullying questionnaires were completed by all pupils last week. There are 2 questions on the questionnaire:

- Would you like to talk to someone about bullying?
- Do you know anyone having a hard time?

Pupils should have no fear about reporting bullying behaviour as all pupils fill in the questinnaires and children involved in any investigations are not informed where the information has come from. Any issues raised are investigated and dealt with by the relevant teacher. As per the Department of Education and Skills guidelines, the emphasis is not on punishment but on getting any bullying behaviours to stop.
