Procedure for Admissions

Step 1

First Year enrolment commences **on November 6**th **2019 and closes on December 6**th **2019.** The closing date is to facilitate the organisation of entrance assessments which take place in January.

(Due to GDPR, testing cannot be carried out on students who have not completed the application process and enrolment process).

A confirmation of acceptance form is then issued to all eligible applicants.

Step 2

Parents/guardians and applicant are then required to sign the confirmation of acceptance form indicating acceptance and return by the closing date on the acceptance form. Failure to return by this date may result in the withdrawal of the offer, and the place may be offered to the next student on the waiting list.

Completed applications (and completed confirmation of acceptance forms) must be sent or brought to the main office where the secretary will ensure that all accompanying documentation is correct and the form is date stamped.

All applications after December 6th are considered late applications. Late applications are considered in line with our admissions policy.
